### **Board Accountability**

The <u>CEO succession plan</u> has also been established to ensure leadership continuity. This structured approach ensures that our directors remain accountable for overseeing business operations in line with established policies, strategic targets, and the long-term value creation objectives that serve our shareholders' interests.

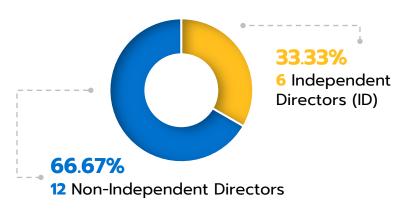

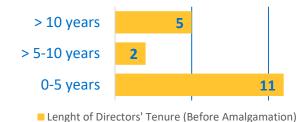
